Junior Code of Conduct

Tennis is a sport of etiquette. Therefore, WRC requires all Junior Development players to follow a code of conduct.

- Bullying or harassment of other players will not be tolerated.
- Love your racquet! Hold your racquet close to you when not playing.
- Listen and follow your instructor's directions.
- Help pick up tennis balls in a timely manner.
- Ask the coach for permission to leave the court.
- Be respectful of other players and the coaches.

If your behavior endangers the safety of others or you do not follow the code of conduct, you will be asked to leave.

BILLING

All Junior Players must have a card on file and be signed up for the EFT program/monthly billing.

Players will receive a monthly statement by email on the 1st of the month. WRC will run the credit card on file for the balance on the 8th of the month for the previous month's balance. Players wishing to pay by cash, check or a different card will need to do so before the 8th of the month.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Due to limited availability, WRC is unable to guarantee makeup classes except in cases of inclement weather.

A credit/refund will not be given for a missed class. In the case of illness or injury, a doctor's note is required to receive a refund/credit for missed classes.

One class fee will be held as a late unregistration fee for leaving the session after payment has been submitted.

If you are asked to leave the program, a refund will not be issued.
